



## **Environmental/ Sustainability Policy**

Here at EFP we have set ourselves the target of being an award winning company for our sustainability stance.

Sustainable development has been built into all aspects of our business; this includes ensuring that our suppliers only use materials from renewable sources. We believe in providing for the needs of today without compromising the needs of the future generations (“development which meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs”).

### **Supply Chain Management**

In purchasing goods and services EFP will pay special attention to objective sustainability criteria when considering price, quality and delivery.

### **Transport**

In all its operation, EFP will take due regard to the fact that its greatest potential impact upon the environment is through the transport generated either directly or indirectly by its activities and will take all necessary action to minimise that impact.

### **Waste management**

- All waste wood will be placed into the skips provided, this can then be recycled lessening the need for more trees to be felled reducing the Environmental impact.

- All waste metals are placed into the correct waste collection receptacles that are to be found on our client's sites, this can then be recycled.
- Waste paper is recycled (collected weekly by the local authority (office))
- All other waste is collected on a weekly basis by the local authority (office).
- Whilst on site EFP employees will use the client's arrangements for waste removal.

Here at EFP we base our waste disposal on the four R's, we will endeavor to;

- **Reduce** our waste where possible, where this is not possible we will.
- **Re-Use** our waste, where this is not possible we will,
- **Recycle** our waste,
- Finally all remaining waste will be **Responsibly** disposed of.
